



RockPointe Small Group Leadership Commitment

1. I will do my best to cultivate an abiding personal relationship with Jesus. (John 15:5, Psalm 105:4)
2. I will support the [mission](#), [doctrinal statements](#) and leadership of RockPointe Church. If I or anyone in my group express a specific concern or issue, I will bring it to my Coach or SG Ministry's attention. (Eph 4:1-3)
3. I will pray for each person in my group at least weekly, as well as pray for the unity, health, and growth of RockPointe Church and Small Group Ministry. (Acts 20:28, 1 Thess 5:17)
4. I will do my best to attend worship regularly (Hebrews 10:25) and attend RPC Small Group leader meetings.
5. I understand community is messy, there will be disagreement and I will need to have difficult conversations. I will be sure to properly address and squelch gossip, profanity, divisive comments, racist remarks, political shaming or sexual innuendos. (Eph. 4:29). I will do my best to uphold and model our guidelines for Biblical Conflict Resolution in my Small Group. (Matthew 18:15-17)
6. I will communicate (or appoint someone else in our group to communicate) updates about Bible Study Curriculum, Small Group event date/times, prayer requests/praises, attendance and care needs within our Small Group. I will be attentive to RPC Small Group staff and volunteer communication, read and respond appropriately and in a timely manner.
7. I will regularly update (or appoint someone else to perform these tasks) our Small Group Calendar, Participant Roster and Take Attendance in the Lead App or myRPC. (1 Cor. 15:58)
8. I maintain moral integrity in my relationships with members of the opposite sex. I will not be alone with a Small Group member of the opposite sex and I will not counsel the opposite sex. (1 Thess. 4:3-5, 1 Cor. 10:13) and I will seek to model Christ and be above reproach in every area of my life including Social Media. (Gal. 5:16)
9. If I enter a season of family turmoil, major loss, grief, suffering, sickness, I will communicate with my Coach and RPC Small Group Ministry team. I will seek the support of our co-leaders and am willing to step back for that season to get the rest, counsel and care I may need. (Eccl. 3:1-8)
10. If I or my co-leader want to leave or disband our Small Group, I will communicate with the Small Group Ministry to prayerfully develop a care plan prior to discussing with my Small Group or ceasing to meet. (1 Cor. 12:25-26)
